- Effect of cannabis on HIV neuropathic pain
- 6 month +
- HIV+ & HIV-related Neuropathic Pain
- 2 components :
- Daily text messaging / surveys (6 months)
- Cannabis administration (3 office visits)
- Initial screen (1 hour)
- In-person medical screen (6-8 hours)
- If eligible, enroll in either or both
- Compensation up to \$570
